With this 6th issue of our monthly newsletter we would like to inform you again about the current status of our joint project "SCIN - Survey on Currently applied Interventions in Neonatal resuscitation" and pass on important information to you.

Recruitment

Last month we continued the recruitment and were able to recruit 2 more clinics as participants. This means **that a total of 54 clinics from 12 countries are now taking part in the survey**. In addition, several international clinics have expressed interest in participating. We are very pleased about the possibility to include further countries. But also from the countries already participating, further clinics are very welcome to take part.

Survey

In total, more than 30,000 children have already been born in the participating clinics during the survey period. Of these births, **a total of 4133 newborns with interventions are now recorded in our database**. We thank you for your continued commitment and look forward to receiving the outstanding data for September!

Important updates
