With this 5th issue of our monthly newsletter we would like to inform you again about the current status of our joint project "SCIN - Survey on Currently applied Interventions in Neonatal resuscitation" and pass on important information to you.

## Recruitment

In the last month we have pushed recruitment especially on an international level and were able to recruit 7 more clinics, including the first from Slovakia. **This brings the total number of hospitals participating in the survey to 52 from a total of 12 countries.** We are very happy about the interest and the possibility to include more countries.
