Professor (W2) of Dermato-Immunology.

This Professorship is integrated in the Department of Dermatology and has a focus on the diagnosis and treatment of patients with chronic inflammatory and autoimmune-related disorders. The aim of this Professorship is the development of clinically meaningful and experimentally based research projects in Dermato-Immunology.

We expect from the applicants to develop interdisciplinary clinically as well as basic research concepts in close cooperation with the University Center for Autoimmune and rheumatological diseases, the University Center for rare diseases, the Excellence Clusters CRTD as well as with the DFG Clinical Research Group (KFO 249). This Professorship includes an attending position at the Department of Dermatology and the leadership of the Division of Dermato-Immunology. Applicants are encouraged to actively participate in the preexisting infrastructures and research topics of the Medical Faculty. The applicants are expected to participate in research and teaching. In this respect we also expect you to engage in the Dresdner model of problem-oriented teaching (DIPOL®) in German as well as in English language and in academic self-governance.

Prerequisites according to § 58 SächsHSFG include a university degree in medicine, a doctoral degree and a post-doctoral degree/habilitation or an equivalent qualification record. Board certification for dermatology is required. The position further requires providing teaching experience, a long experience in conducting clinical and translational studies and records in third-party fund raising.

The employment of professors with medical tasks is carried out at the University Hospital Dresden in the scope of non-pay-scale employment contracts with a basic remuneration and a performance- and success-related compensation.

The Faculty of Medicine seeks to employ more women in leadership positions. Hence, qualified women are encouraged to apply. Applications from qualified disabled candidates or those with in need of additional support are welcome.
