## **Professor (W2) of Geriatric Psychiatry**

The holder of the professorship will be the head of the Division of Geriatric Psychiatry at the Department of Psychiatry and Psychotherapy. The Division of Geriatric Psychiatry is composed of an interdisciplinary inpatient unit, and a large outpatient section (memory clinic), which focuses on the diagnostics and treatment of mild cognitive impairment and dementia syndromes. The future development of existing geriatric day care clinic resources is a specific aim of the Department of Psychiatry and Psychotherapy, and of the Faculty of Medicine.

Essential responsibilities of this position are to represent the aforementioned field in health care, research, and medical education (in German and English language) as well as to establish and continue successful projects within the scope of national and international research collaborations.

The Faculty of Medicine is looking for a highly accomplished personality with a strong expertise in neuropsychiatric research – from neuropsychological aspects to biological markers, specifically magnetic resonance imaging. Main research focuses of the Department of Psychiatry are the early detection of psychiatric diseases and their prodromal stages as well as investigating the predictive value of neurobiological characteristics. The incumbent should have a research record in the field of risk factors for neurocognitive disorders to further strengthen the department's research strategy in accordance with the official scientific core areas of the Faculty of Medicine: "Neurological and psychiatric disorders" and "Imaging and technology development". Another central responsibility is to establish and to continue collaborations with the Center for Healthy Aging, several clinical and research groups in the field of neuroscience within the Medical Faculty and the Technische Universität Dresden, and with the German Center for Neurodegenerative Diseases (DZNE). The holder of the position has a proven record of international peer-reviewed scientific publications as well as of successful procurement of third-party funding.

The employment of professors with medical tasks is carried out in the scope of non-pay-scale employment contracts with a basic remuneration and a performance- and success-based compensation.

Prerequisites according to § 58 SächsHSG include a university degree in medicine, a doctoral degree and a post-doctoral degree/habilitation or demonstration of equivalent qualifications. The nature of the position further requires a valid board certification in psychiatry and psychotherapy, longstanding practical-clinical experience (in a supervisory position) in the field of geriatric psychiatry, specifically in a memory clinic, and longstanding teaching experience.

The Faculty of Medicine seeks to employ more women in leadership positions. Hence, qualified women are encouraged to apply. Applications from qualified disabled candidates or those with in need of additional support are welcome.
