### **Professor (W2) of Interdisciplinary Plastic Surgery and Hand Surgery**

The University Centre of Orthopedics and Traumatology (OUC) of the University Hospital Carl Gustav Carus Dresden is providing tertiary care of all musculoskeletal disorders and injuries within a specialized subunit structure. A new subunit of Plastic Surgery and Hand Surgery shall be established in order to complete the therapeutic spectrum in the field of large bone and soft tissue defects after severe extremity trauma, musculoskeletal tumor resections and infections. In addition to care provision within the OUC, interdisciplinary plastic-reconstructive services for partner clinics (i.e. Obstetrics and Gynecology, Visceral, Thoracic and Vascular Surgery) are included in the position. We are seeking a candidate with excellent clinical and scientific qualification, who in addition has an outstanding reputation in hand surgery as well as plastic-reconstructive surgery of the musculoskeletal system, breast reconstruction and bariatric surgery. The professorship requires intensive communication with cooperation partners in surgical departments, University Cancer Center and University Plastic Aesthetic Center.

We expect you to strengthen the interdisciplinary scientific focus of OUC and CRTD Dresden with research activities in the field of regenerative medicine. We also expect you to engage in the Dresdner model of problem-oriented teaching (DIPOL®) as well as in english language teaching and in academic self-governance.

Prerequisites according to § 58 SächsHSFG include a university degree in medicine, a doctoral degree and a post-doctoral degree/habilitation or demonstration of equivalent qualifications. The nature of the position further requires to provide teaching experience and records in third-party fund raising. Applicants must have a board certification as Plastic and Aesthetic Surgeon as well as Hand Surgeon.

The employment of professors with medical tasks is carried out in the scope of non-pay-scale employment contracts with a basic remuneration and a performance- and success-related compensation.

The Faculty of Medicine seeks to employ more women in leadership positions. Hence, qualified women are encouraged to apply. Applications from qualified disabled candidates or those with additional support needs are welcome.
