The prospective holder of the position shall follow an independent animal experimental approach to basic science in the field of psychiatry. Ideally, the successful applicant is internationally known by relevant peer reviewed publications and can provide a track record of third-party funding acquisition. The professorship has a scientific focus on neurobiological substrates of aberrant behaviour and translational development of innovative therapeutic strategies. The successful applicant is experienced in characterizing, validating and applying animal models of psychiatric disorders and holds a comprehensive methodological spectrum. Integration into the neuroscientific environment of the Faculty of Medicine and a close cooperation with groups in this and related fields is requested. The Department of Psychiatry and Psychotherapy offers the possibility for clinical work in the field of neuropsychiatric disorders.

In accordance with § 58 SächsHSFG (Law on Higher Education of the German federal state of Saxony), candidates must have completed university studies in human medicine, show a proven track record in teaching, a doctorate and habilitation or the equivalent of habilitation, as well as a board certification in Psychiatry and Psychotherapy that allows for practicing in this medical field in Germany.

The Faculty of Medicine seeks to increase the proportion of women in science and teaching and explicitly invites qualified female scientists to apply. Applications from candidates with disabilities are welcome.
