The position also requires expertise in laboratory management, especially of the laboratory of immunohistology. With your experience in quality management you will also support us in the planned accreditation of the laboratory.

Your special dedication to teaching of medical students and to designing and carrying out innovative and practice oriented teaching concepts is highly appreciated, and we welcome your engagement in academic self-administration.

The employment of professors with medical tasks is carried out at the University Hospital Dresden in the scope of non-pay-scale employment contracts with a basic remuneration and a performance- and success-related compensation.

Prerequisites according to § 58 SächsHSFG include a university degree and a doctoral degree in medicine, postdoctoral experience or other experience equivalent to the German habilitation and teaching experience as well as a board certification in the field of pathology. Ideally, you have an internationally recognized research profile and a track-record in third-party funding.
