The position is integrated in the Department for Visceral-, Thoracic- and Vascular Surgery, and will head the section of Thoracic Surgery in the Department.

The aim of this position is to represent and develop thoracic surgery in the clinical field, in research and teaching. Due to the interdisciplinary character of thoracic surgery, you will cooperate closely with the University Cancer Center/NCT as well as with the other departments and institutes of the University Hospital and the Technische Universität Dresden and with the partners of the "Ostdeutschen Lungenzentrum".

You have an excellent clinical and scientific qualification with an outstanding reputation in thoracic surgery including expertise in open and minimally invasive/robotic surgery, HITOC and laser surgery. In addition, you should have a research focus in thoracic surgery and ideally have a long experience in conducting clinical and translational studies.

We want you to integrate in the structures and research profile of the Faculty of Medicine. We also expect your commitment in the Dresdner model of problem-oriented teaching in German and in English language and in academic self-governance.

Prerequisites according to § 58 SächsHSFG include a university degree in medicine, a doctoral degree and a post-doctoral degree/habilitation or demonstration of equivalent qualifications. The nature of the position further requires teaching experience and records in third-party fund raising. Applicants must have a board certification as Thoracic Surgeon.

The employment of professors with medical tasks is carried out in the scope of non-pay-scale employment contracts with a basic remuneration and a performance- and success-related compensation.

The Faculty of Medicine seeks to employ more women in leadership positions and strongly encourages qualified women to apply. We also welcome applications from qualified candidates with disabilities or those with additional support needs.
