Professor (W2) of Vascular and Endovascular Surgery

The position will be embedded in the Department of Visceral-, Thoracic and Vascular Surgery, University Hospital Carl Gustav Carus, Technische Universität Dresden and will be in charge of the Section of Vascular and Endovascular Surgery.

The aim of this position is to develop Vascular and Endovascular Surgery in the clinical field, in research and teaching. Due to the interdisciplinary character of modern vascular medicine, we expect close cooperation with the University Vascular Center (UGC) as well as with the other departments and institutes of the University Hospital and the Technische Universität.

We are seeking a candidate with excellent clinical and scientific qualification with an outstanding reputation in Vascular and Endovascular Surgery. The candidate should have a research focus in translational vascular medicine and ideally has a long experience in conducting clinical and translational studies. We expect integration in the structures and research profile of the Medical Faculty.

We also expect the candidate to engage in the Dresdner model of problem-oriented teaching (DIPOL®) as well as in English language teaching and in academic self-governance.

Prerequisites according to § 58 SächsHSFG include a university degree in medicine, a doctoral degree and a post-doctoral degree/habilitation or demonstration of equivalent qualifications. The nature of the position further requires to provide teaching experience and records in third-party fund raising. Applicants must have a board certification as General or Visceral Surgeon.

The employment of professors with medical tasks is carried out at the University Hospital Dresden in the scope of non-pay-scale employment contracts with a basic remuneration and a performance- and success-related compensation.

The Faculty of Medicine seeks to employ more women in leadership positions. Hence, qualified women are encouraged to apply. Applications from qualified disabled candidates or those with additional support needs are welcome.
