The Department of Gynecology and Obstetrics is one of the leading hospitals in Germany, especially for obstetrics and perinatology. Because of a very good centralization concerning high risk pregnancies our level I perinatal center has high numbers of premature babies and high-risk pregnancies, with a high quality with low caesarean section rate and very good fetal outcome.

The professorship is affiliated to the Department of Gynecology and Obstetrics of the University Hospital Carl Gustav Carus Dresden. This functional area fulfills central tasks in research, teaching and patient care. We are looking for a clinically and scientifically highly experienced personality in prenatal and perinatal medicine with main focus on intrauterine therapy. As a future job holder, you are already known as a research personality in the field of obstetrics and prenatal medicine and especially experienced in the field of intrauterine interventional therapy, with a multi-year international education for fetal medicine. Fetal surgery is to be carried out independently. Furthermore, you should be nationally and internationally networked. You have experience in the acquisition, coordination and management of third-party projects. We place special emphasis on the interaction with neonatology and pediatric surgery in the jointly founded center for fetoneonatal health. In addition to experience in health services research, there should be collaborations in the context of translational and fundamental research, which should be further expanded. Expertise in the field of health services research, prevention and public health are highly desirable in cooperation with clinicians and resident practices and hereby you should have ongoing supra-regional projects. You have expertise in leading and establishment of a biobank with successful publication activity in internationally leading journals. We also wish a special commitment in teaching at the campus Dresden, as well as in the context of the model degree course in Chemnitz and, moreover, in the implementation of the dual bachelor's degree course in midwifery planned for 2021. As an academic contact, you will establish the research focus of the dual bachelor's degree course in midwifery.

The employment of professors with medical duties takes place within the framework of non-tariff employee contracts with basic remuneration as well as performance- and success-related remuneration components.

The prerequisites for employment according to § 58 SächsHSFG are a university degree in medicine, doctorate, and habilitation or habilitation-equivalent achievement. You have a track record in teaching and of internationally reviewed publications and a successful acquisition of third-party grants.
