The Professor will be part of the Institute for Medical Microbiology and Hygiene (Head: Prof. Dr. med. A. Dalpke) and should enforce the scientific foci of the Institute. We are looking especially for a candidate with expertise in infection and immunity and micro-biome/host interactions. You should be recognized internationally and should have a record in third-party fund raising.

We expect you to actively participate in the preexisting infrastructures and research topics of the Faculty of Medicine, especially in the field of Immunology and Metabolics, and envisage you to represent the field of Infection Biology in research and teaching. We expect you to also participate actively in preexisting cooperative research groups and to cooperate with institutions of the TU Dresden as the excellence cluster Center for Re-generative Therapies Dresden (CRTD) as well as external non university research institutions as the Max Planck- or Helmholtz-Institutes.

We also anticipate your dedication to the Dresdner model of problem-oriented teaching in German and in English language, as well as your commitment in academic self-governance.

The employment of professors with medical tasks is carried out at the University Hospital Dresden in the scope of non-pay-scale employment contracts with a basic remuneration and a performance- and success-related compensation.

Prerequisites according to § 58 SächsHSFG include a university degree in medicine or natural sciences, a doctoral degree and a post-doctoral degree/habilitation or an equivalent qualification record. Board certification for Microbiology, Virology and Infectious Disease Epidemiology and contributing to the diagnostic duties of the institute is desirable but not mandatory.

The Faculty of Medicine aspires to increase the number of women in research and teaching, and strongly encourages qualified women to apply for this position. We also welcome applications from scientists with disabilities.
