The chair is associated with the supervision of the section of periodontology of the polyclinic of operative dentistry. We welcome your special commitment to the establishment of the new AOZ (Approbationsordnung für Zahnärzte und Zahnärztinnen) and the realization of interdisciplinary and inter-professional teaching concepts in dentistry as well as in academic self-administration.

You are nationally and internationally visible with your scientific expertise and your scientific profile fits well into our clinical research topics (e.g. clinical-controlled trials on prevention and therapy of periodontal diseases) as well as our bioscientific research focus (e.g. etiopathogenesis, interaction of periodont and human organism, bio-adhesion processes) at the polyclinic of operative dentistry and the UZM (UniversitätsZahnMedizin). Requirements for appointment according to § 58 SächsHSFG are a completed university degree in dentistry, doctorate, habilitation or equivalent achievement and teaching experience as well as special clinical expertise in the field of periodontology with a corresponding advanced training degree (specialist, master or comparable). Ideally, you already have extensive experience in attracting third-party funding as well as relevant management and leadership experience.

The employment of professors with medical tasks is carried out according to non-pay scale employment contracts with a basic remuneration and performance- and success-related remuneration components.

The Faculty of Medicine seeks to employ more women in leadership positions and strongly encourages qualified women to apply. We also welcome applications from qualified candidates with disabilities or those with additional support needs.
