The chair will be part of Medical Department 1. The chair will also head the interdisciplinary Early Clinical Trial Unit at the NCT/UCC Dresden. We aim at establishing this unit as one of the internationally leading centers for early phase clinical research in hematology and oncology.

As future holder of the chair of experimental tumor therapy, you will represent the subject comprehensively in both research and teaching. We are looking for a person who will foster the interaction of all departments organized within the NCT/UCC and establish novel interfaces with research groups at the Center for Regenerative Therapies Dresden (CRTD), the Max-Planck-Institute for Cell Biology and Genetics (MPI-CBG), the Biotechnology Center at TU Dresden (BIOTEC) and the Else-Kröner-Fresenius Center for Digital Health. In particular, we look forward to your commitment in the Dresden Model of problem-based learning and in academic self-administration.

We wish for a collaborative research personality with several years of leadership experience and proven expertise in both solid malignancies and hematologic neoplasms. You have extensive experience in the conception and conduct of early phase (incl. first-in-human) clinical trials in these subjects as well as in the development and validation of tools for cost-covering operation in clinical contract research. You excel in the ability to successfully collaborate in interdisciplinary investigator groups. Your management skills are clearly above average and you are familiar with and sensitive to the economic aspects of your work. Your personal clinical research agenda integrates into the current spectrum of the NCT/UCC expertise. In addition, you have a proven track record of internationally reviewed publications and successful acquisition of third party grants.

Prerequisites according to § 58 SächsHSFG include a university degree in medicine, a doctoral degree and a post-doctoral degree/habilitation or an equivalent qualification record. Board certification as hematologist/oncologist is required. The employment of professors with medical tasks is carried out according to non-pay scale employment contracts with a basic remuneration and performance- and success-related remuneration components. The Faculty of Medicine seeks to employ more women in leadership positions and strongly encourages qualified women to apply. We also welcome applications from qualified candidates with disabilities or those with additional support needs.
