The chair is affiliated with the Institute of Clinical Chemistry and Laboratory Medicine of the University Hospital "Carl Gustav Carus" Dresden. We place particular emphasis on research of the interaction between cell metabolism and other fundamental processes in cells and tissues (such as growth control and differentiation or regulation of inflammation), which represent a common pathomechanism in the field of cardiac or cardio-metabolic diseases or steatosis. We also expect you to be highly cooperative, to be particularly committed to teaching (Course Clinical Chemistry) and to laboratory medical diagnostics as well as to participate in academic self-administration.

You are already known as a research personality in the field of cell metabolism in cardiac or cardio-metabolic diseases and have experience in attracting external funding. You also have a successful publication record in the field of cell metabolism in cardiac or cardio-metabolic diseases that strengthens the research focus "Metabolic Diseases" with innovative scientific and methodological approaches.

Prerequisites according to § 58 SächsHSFG include a university degree in medicine, a doctoral degree and a post-doctoral degree/habilitation or an equivalent qualification record and a board certification for laboratory medicine.

The employment of professors with medical tasks is carried out according to non-pay scale employment contracts with a basic remuneration and performance- and success-related remuneration components.

The Faculty of Medicine seeks to employ more women in leadership positions and strongly encourages qualified women to apply. We also welcome applications from qualified candidates with disabilities or those with additional support needs.
