Professor and Chair (W3) of Psychological and Social Medicine

The holder of the aforementioned professorship will be the director of the independent Division of Psychological and Social Medicine associated with the Center for Mental Health. Essential responsibilities of this position are to represent the aforementioned field in health care, research, and medical education (in German and English language) as well as to establish and continue successful projects within the scope of national and international research collaborations. Another central responsibility is to establish collaborations between the departments of the Center for Mental Health, additional institutes and clinics of the Faculty of Medicine, and facilities of the TU Dresden that are invested in neuroscientific research – in particular the Department of Psychology and existing collaborative research initiatives.

Therefore, the Faculty of Medicine is looking for a highly accomplished personality with excellent national and international clinical and research record who will help to further clinical and scientific activities and infrastructure in accordance with the official scientific core areas of the Faculty of Medicine: “Neurological and psychiatric disorders” and “Imaging and technology development”. The chair is also expected to have professional competence regarding developmental aspects – from childhood to adulthood.

The incumbent has a proven record of international peer-reviewed scientific publications as well as of successful procurement and implementation of peer-reviewed third-party funded projects in the field of clinical neuroscience. The Faculty of Medicine is seeking to strengthen existing research areas, in particular in the field of eating disorders. Further qualifications including excellent clinical abilities and longstanding experience in psychotherapeutic treatments are obligatory. To facilitate translational clinical research, it is expected that the chair will take on significant clinical responsibilities. In addition, successful applicants are required to have experience and proven leadership skills regarding the successful management of human resources as well as financial controlling (in the clinical sector).

The employment of professors with medical tasks is carried out in the scope of non-pay-scale employment contracts with a basic remuneration and a performance- and success-based compensation.

Prerequisites according to § 58 SächsHSFG include a university degree in medicine, a doctoral degree and a post-doctoral degree/habilitation or demonstration of equivalent qualifications. The nature of the position further requires a valid board certification in psychiatry, child and adolescent psychiatry or psychosomatic medicine, longstanding practical-clinical experience (in a supervisory position) and teaching experience.

The Faculty of Medicine seeks to employ more women in leadership positions. Hence, qualified women are encouraged to apply. Applications from qualified disabled candidates or those with in need of additional support are welcome.
