The Department and Outpatients Department of Psychotherapy and Psychosomatic Medicine at the University Hospital Dresden offers inpatient, semi-inpatient, outpatient treatment as well as a consultation and liaison service and is part of the Center for Mental Health.

The chair will be head of the Department and Outpatients Department of Psychotherapy and Psychosomatic Medicine, while also strengthening interdisciplinary cooperation and interfaces of the department, in particular with perinatal medicine, gynecology, orthopedics, surgery and dentistry and representing the subject of psychosomatic medicine and psychotherapy comprehensively in clinics, research and teaching. Strengthening the depth-psychological profile of the department is welcome. In addition, the chair holder's scientific agenda should integrate patient-related research as well as the area of health services research. In particular, we look forward to your commitment in academic boards and the promotion of young talents as well as your expertise in the area of employee health and your active participation in our center for employee health. In addition, we welcome your active engagement in the newly introduced forms of knowledge transfer and in the Longitudinal Curriculum "Communicative and Social Skills".

Ideally, your focus will be on integrated psychosomatic and depth psychology-based psychotherapeutic clinical practice and patient-oriented health services research. You have proven expertise in providing the entire spectrum of psychosomatic-psychotherapeutic services as well as profound knowledge in psychosomatic consultation and liaison service and in cross-sectoral care. In addition, you can demonstrate several years of experience in economically successful clinic management in a university environment or maximum care hospital. You also have experience in the implementation and evaluation of inpatient, trans-sectoral care concepts and demonstrate a high degree of willingness to collaborate intensively with institutes and clinics both inside and outside the Faculty of Medicine.

Prerequisites according to § 58 SächsHSFG include a university degree in medicine, a doctoral degree and a post-doctoral degree/habilitation or an equivalent qualification record. Board certification as a specialist in psychosomatic medicine and psychotherapy or psychotherapeutic medicine with a focus on depth psychology is required. The prerequisites for the permission of a further training authorization for medical specialists in psychosomatic medicine and psychotherapy by the Saxon State Medical Association must be fulfilled.

The employment of professors with medical tasks is carried out according to non-pay scale employment contracts with a basic remuneration and performance- and success-related remuneration components.

The Faculty of Medicine seeks to employ more women in leadership positions and strongly encourages qualified women to apply. We also welcome applications from qualified candidates with disabilities or those with additional support needs.
